FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Dear Members and Friends of TaB "Grace to you and peace from God out Father and the Lord Jesus Christ".

Today marks the first Sunday of Advent for 2020, and our Sanctuary is still closed because of Covid-19. Many of us over the past nine months have endured several challenges because of this Covid-19 pandemic. As we are now in a time of severe disruption, it is expedient for me to refer to a period when God's people were also troubled.

In Ezekiel Chapter 34; we read of God's words to Ezekiel, concerning the shepherds of Israel failure to look after God's people, his sheep in a proper manner. It is interesting, however, to note verse three "You eat the fat, you clothe yourselves with the wool... but you do not feed the sheep". In this period of covid-19, when many of our members are in isolation, we can all do our little bit to ensure that our members are feeling loved, cared for and safe.

Sisters and brothers God himself has sought us out and has protected us over the past eight months from this Virus. All praise and glory to His name for his redeeming Grace. He will protect and guide in the months ahead. Let us gather on the 6th December to render praises to his holy name.

LECTIONARY REFLECTION

Lectionary Readings: Isaiah 64:1-9, Psalm 80:1-7, 17-19,1 Corinthians 1:3-9 & Mark 13:24-37



29th November 2020 is the first Sunday of Advent, and therefore it is not surprising to see a common reference to The Coming of The Lord in all the four readings.

In Isaiah 64, one can observe that The Lord is being called upon to pardon his chosen people and come down to save them. Again, Psalm80 echoes the same plea:

Restore us, God Almighty; make your face shine on us, that we may be saved.

The passage from 1 Corinthians has a more direct message:

Therefore, you do not lack any spiritual gift as you eagerly wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed. He will also keep you firm to the end, so that you will be blameless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Then in Mark 13, we are told:


In the days after that time of trouble the sun will grow dark, the moon will no longer shine, the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers in space will be driven from their courses. Then the Son of Man will appear, coming in the clouds with great power and glory. He will send the angels out to the four corners of the earth to gather God's chosen people from one end of the world to the other.

Maybe we can take comfort that this transition into Advent is particularly relevant today, and should give us hope for the future as we attempt to survive and thrive in the prevailing circumstances.

I will end here with some words from a modern hymn by Laurence Wareing.

And I will wait now, and in the waiting feel still more closely your love for me.
For I'll be patient and I'll be gentle, touched by your steadfast humility.
